First place in each class will receive a trophy and ribbons will be awarded to 1st through 4th place. BEST VETERAN, BOS VETERAN, BEST COURSING CHAMPION AND BOS COURSING CHAMPION. First place in each class will receive a trophy and ribbons will be awarded to 1st through 4th place.

SCGSF BEST IN MATCH TROPHY will be awarded to the saluki judged Best in Match. This trophy is the property of SCGSF and may be taken only by a voting member in good standing. A picture of the trophy may be presented to an associate member or a non-member that is awarded Best in Match. The trophy is to be returned to the SCGSF prior to, or on the day of, the next match.
